We are using an online Learning Journey – Tapestry, which most of you are familiar with. We will also be using Tapestry to give you information about school routines over the next few weeks so please make sure you check regularly and give us a 'like' so we know you have seen the posts

Our Term 1 topic is 'Marvellous me' and will focus on settling into school life, making new friends and thinking about how amazing we all are! You will be able to access a 'topic web' and 'knowledge organiser' on the school website and Tapestry at the beginning of each long term (September, after Easter and after Christmas)

Routines

Focused teaching of PE will be on a Wednesday. Please make sure ALL PE kit is named and kept in school.

Read Write Inc Phonics

We will start teaching the sounds on Monday 12th September. Please check book bags daily for handwriting homework sheets and send them back to school for House Points!

Children will need their wellies and a suitable coat at school every day as we play on the field in all weathers. Your child will bring home 3 reading books at a time. Reading books should be in school daily and will be changed once a week. We will change books that have been read at home so please make sure you record in the yellow reading record. Reading is a vital life skill and in Reception, phonics/reading is a focus area. Please hear your child read at home at least 3 times a week to support their learning at school.

Health and Safety

To help keep children safe, could you please refrain from letting your children play on the playground equipment (castle, trim trail and bikes) before and after school.

Phonics

We invite you to a phonics and reading workshop on **Tuesday 4th October at 3.15pm** to outline how we teach phonics at school, give an overview of the phonics scheme we use and how you can help at home. We have already started teaching phonics and the children have been bringing homework sheets home! Please sit with your child and have a go at the letters but don't worry if they aren't keen to do it – it's all new to them. Please send any attempts back to school as children will receive house points for their efforts!

Our Christian Value this term is "**Caring**". We will be talking about how we care for each other, and for ourselves. This will focus on positive mental health and good hygiene habits (handwashing, using tissues etc.)
