



Maths

We will use the 'White Rose' maths scheme to help us understand doubling, sharing and grouping, odds and evens and spatial reasoning.

We will also be continuing our Numbersense sessions 4 times a week.

Literacy

Phonics -We will continue with individualised learning for Set 1, 2 or 3 sounds. We will be sequencing and writing stories linked to our chosen texts; The Tiny Seed - Eric Carle, Titch - Pat Hutchins and Charlie and Lola look after your planet. We will also be retelling nursery rhymes and having a go at writing them.



Communication & Language

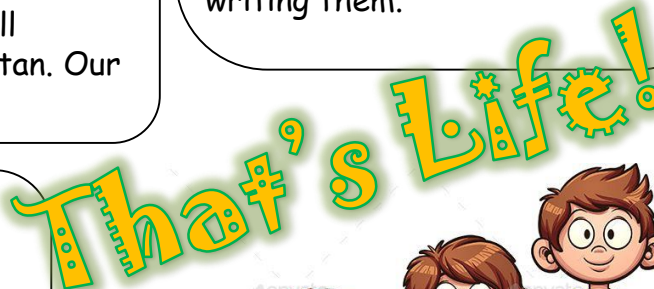
We will continue to listen to stories, rhymes and songs and sequence a series of familiar events. We will use our listening skills to identify when it is time to talk and when it is time to listen when having a conversation.

Religious Education

We will be investigating what stories are special and why? Thinking about stories we like, and stories from the bible. We will reenact the story of The Good Samaritan. Our Christian value this term is 'Courage'.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

This term's PSHE topic is 'Changing Me'. We will be talking about our bodies and what the different parts do, how we respect our bodies, growing up, how we have fun and what our fears are.



Understanding the World

We will be planting seeds and bulbs - what do they need to grow? We will be keeping a diary of the changes we see as they grow. At Forest School we will be thinking about recycling and how we can help to look after our world.



Expressive Art and Design

We will be making seed lifecycle hats, seed pictures and junk modelling bird feeders. We will also be singing and dancing as part of our graduation celebrations.
