

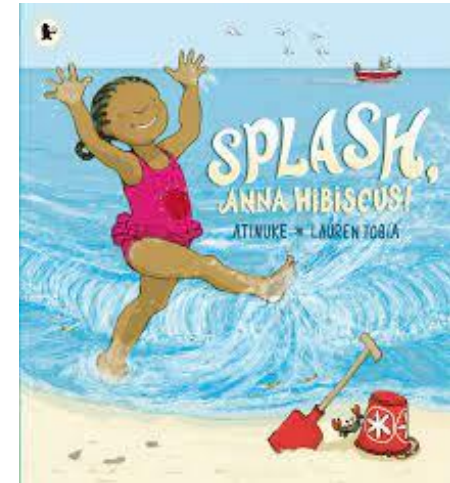
# Why is our World Wonderful?
