PE

Read Write Inc Phonics

The children were assessed at the end of last term to identify which sounds and knowledge they have retained. They will be taught in phonics groups tailored to their needs.

Reading books should be in school daily and will be changed once a week. We will change books that have been read at home so please make sure you record in the yellow reading record.
