
This non-fiction text will allow the children to explore the features of non-fiction books and learn more about a contrasting locality. We will listen to poems from this book each day..





This text will provide opportunities for sequencing and creating a story map. We will predict what might happen and think about the plot. We will act out parts of the story to explore the character's emotions.




