



Maths

We will be developing an understanding of number. The children will meet the characters from 'Numberblocks' to reinforce number recognition and formation. We will also experiment with pattern during shape and measure sessions.

Religious Education

This term the Christian Value is 'Caring'. We will think about what this means and how we can show it everyday and everywhere. In RE we will learn about Creation through interesting activities, and thinking about the wonders of the natural world.

Communication & Language

We will encourage good listening skills through games and activities. Children will engage in role play in literacy lessons and in their free play. There will be many opportunities for discussions based around our topic. The children will share their 'Special bags' and tell their friends about their toys and photos etc.



Literacy

We will start to learn and revise the 'Set 1' sounds from our phonics scheme, blending and segmenting them to read and write words! Together we will enjoy listening to a range of stories and joining in with nursery rhymes. Together we will be learning how to form our cursive letters when we write our names and in phonics! Our focus texts will be 'Here we are', 'Elmer' and 'You Choose'.

Understanding the World

We will be accessing technology using iPads. We will learn about features of our immediate environment and talk about differences and similarities. We will use our special bags to discuss past and present moments in our lives.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will explore working with different materials, colours and textures to create Elmer pictures and self portraits. We will also explore colour mixing to match our skin, hair and eye colour.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

This term the children will be creating class rules with their friends and discussing why we need them. Our topic is 'Being Me in My World' and we will all be getting to know each other by playing games, turn taking, trying new activities and talking about our likes and dislikes. The children will talk about what makes a good friend and think about what makes them happy and sad.

Physical Development

The children will develop their fine motor skills through our 'Funky Fingers' activities. In PE lessons the children will develop basic fundamental skills such as co-ordination and balancing as they take part in different activities.
