

Maths

We will be following the 'White Rose' scheme for maths focussing on numbers to 10. This will include simple addition and basic place value. The children will be comparing numbers and learning about time (sequencing pictures).



Literacy

We will continue with our Phonics programme. Children will be encouraged to write words and simple sentences when they are ready. There are daily rainbow writing challenges set within the classroom and outdoor areas to support the children to write initial sounds, words, captions and sentences.



Communication & Language

We will continue to perfect listening skills through games and activities. Children will engage in role play in literacy lessons and in their free play. There will be opportunities for learning new vocabulary as we learn poems and listen to stories.

Religious Education

Our Christian Value is to be '*Perseverance*'. The children will be looking at the story of creation and what God means to Christians around the world through stories from the Bible.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

This term we focus on '*Dreams and Goals*', discussing how to set yourself goals, stay motivated and keep trying their best even when something is really challenging. The children will also find out how it is also important to help others to achieve.



Expressive Art and Design

The children will play musical instruments and will be exposed to a diverse range of music and songs. Children will have opportunities to engage in creative activities through free choice painting, drawing and model making. We will all be making sock puppets this term, working with a range of materials.



Understanding the World

We will be talking about where animals live and thinking about creating a suitable habitat for a 'Bog Baby'. In Forest School we will explore habitats in more detail. We will learn how to program a simple robot to move where we want it to go using the Beebots.



Physical Development

The children will continue their weekly PE sessions. They will also face many more gross motor physical challenges during our weekly Forest School sessions. We provide many opportunities for the children to strengthen and develop their fine motor skills through planned 'Funky Fingers' activities, action songs and craft activities.
