





Manster Mayhem

It is now Term 3 and the beginning of a new decade 2020! There is a whole new topic being introduced this term which is called 'Monster Mayhem'. The principle book of the term is 'Bedtime for Monsters' written and illustrated by Ed Verve.

'Do you ever wonder if somewhere, not too far away, there might be MONSTERS? This charming and funny book takes children on a journey to find out what monsters are really like. This clever tale explores different layers of meaning, with one story being conveyed through the text and another through the illustrations, with a touching ending that should allay fears of the monster under the bed'.

Later in the term will move into poetry of both a wintery and monster related themes. By the end of this period the children will have experience of writing narratives with in-depth details of characters (what do they look like, move, talk and smell like) and then have the confidence and pride of reading them to their peers. The children will also discover that there is a poet inside them.

In the topic web you will find that some themes are repeated. This was due to the practice and scheduling of the Christmas performance so, ICT, PE and Art/ History will continue into this term.
