

## Maths

We will be following the 'White Rose' scheme for maths focussing on numbers to 20 and place value. We will be teaching basic addition and subtraction.



## English

We will continue with our Phonics programme. Children will be encouraged to write words and simple sentences. We will be reading stories about monsters and using these to create writing opportunities. The aim is that children will enjoy reading and become more confident in using writing as a means of communication. Children will also be taught reading skills through guided reading sessions and handwriting to improve their letter formation.



## Religious Education

Our Christian Value is to be '*Perseverance*'. The children will be looking at the story of creation and what God means to Christians around the world through stories from the Bible.

## Computing

We will learn how to program a simple robot to move where we want it to go using the Beebots.



## Personal, Social, Emotional Development

This term we focus on '*Dreams and Goals*', discussing how to set yourself goals, stay motivated and keep trying their best even when something is really challenging. The children will also find out how it is also important to help others to achieve.



## Science

We will be talking about where animals live and thinking about creating a suitable habitat for a 'Bog Baby'. In Forest School we will explore habitats in more detail.



## Art and Design and Music

The children will play musical instruments and will be exposed to a diverse range of music and songs. Children will have opportunities to engage in creative activities through free choice painting, drawing and model making. We will all be making sock puppets this term, working with a range of materials.

## Physical Development

The children will continue their weekly PE sessions. This term we will be focusing on the basic shapes in gymnastics. They will also face many more gross motor physical challenges during our weekly Forest School sessions.
