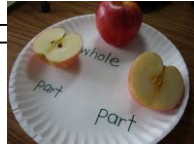


Maths

We now move onto subtraction. The children will need to understand the changing relationship of numbers within the part-whole model and fact families when you introduce the '-' symbol. Once they have mastered this skill, they will then begin to compare addition and subtraction statements.



English

We will continue to work on our reading writing and phonic skills. The children will be guided through being able to create their own story narratives within a monster theme. We will then move onto poetry, learning how to recite existing poems with confidence and then create their own.

Science/ Geography

Our Christian Value this term is 'Perseverance'.



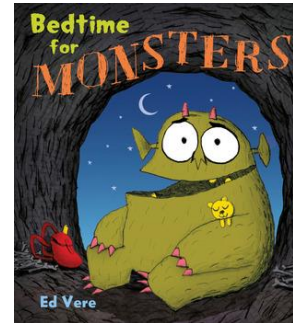
Monster Mayhem
