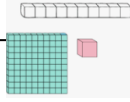


Maths

We will be continuing learning about addition and subtraction, using different practical and written methods to help us. We will be beginning to explore multiplication and also learning about money.



English

This term we will be reading the story of 'George and the Dragon' and doing lots of different writing based around it with the result being writing our own version of the story. We will also be doing some Christmas based writing too.



Religious Education

We will be learning about 'Incarnation.' We will be focusing on the importance of Christmas to Christians and will explore Advent and the nativity. We will also look at the French celebration of Epiphany.

PSHE

Our unit is called 'Celebrating difference.' We will explore how stereotypes can be formed about boys and girls before recognising our own similarities and differences with our friends. We will discuss what bullying is and what to do about it.



Computing

Our unit is called 'Creating Pictures' We will use 2Paint a Picture to create different styles of pictures based upon the style of different artists including Mondrian and Monet.

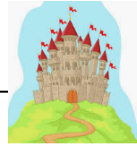
Music
