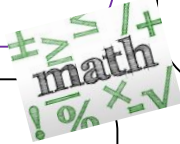


Maths

This term is number and place value to 20. Children will learn to partition teen numbers into tens and ones. They will then learn to add and subtract with totals up to 20 using the knowledge of number bonds to make 10 within a calculation.



Phonics

We are going to continue developing our phonic knowledge. The children have been assessed and will receive lessons targeted to stretch the understanding of reading and spelling. We will use Super Sonic Phonics to support this.



Science/

In Science we will look at materials and try a few practical experiments. In Geography we will continue to explore the Oceans, Continents and then venture closer to home with the UK and our own town.

Religious Education

This term our Christian value is 'Curiosity'. Children will learn about this in their RE lessons investigating a different religion and will watch worships dedicated to value.

English

The children will be exposed to fiction and Non Fictional stories over the course of the term and will write to inform as well as to entertain. Children will be expected to use the correct punctuation, use adjectives and connectives when writing.

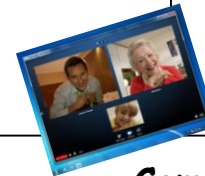
PSHE
