Key Vocabulary:

Subtract	to take away from a whole, or larger amount.
Double	twice the amount, number, size etc..
Courage	Courage is the ability to do something difficult even when there's risk.
Half	One of two equal parts.
Human geography	Human geography focuses on where people live, what they do, and how they use the land e.g. cities and farms.
Physical geography	Physical geographers observe, measure, and describe Earth's surface. They study how landforms develop and how they change.
An adjective	is a describing word e.g. soft, green, pointy etc...
Omnivore	An omnivore is an animal that has the ability to eat and survive on both plant and animal matter.
Carnivore	A carnivore is an animal which eats only meat.
Herbivore	Herbivores are animals that only eat plants.
