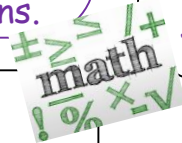


## Maths

This term is addition and subtraction within 20, moving on to Number: Place value within 50. We will continue to use a range of approaches and resources to help answer a variety of questions. We will also start to look at doubling and halving in our Early Bird Maths sessions.



## Phonics

We are going to continue developing our phonic knowledge. The children have been assessed and will receive lessons targeted to stretch the understanding of reading and spelling. We will use Super Sonic Phonics to support this.



## Science

In Science we are looking at the different animal groups, starting with mammals and moving on to labelling the basic parts of the human body. We will then use our animal knowledge to consider the terms omnivore, carnivore and herbivore.

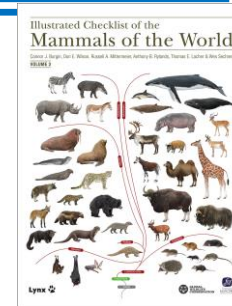
## Religious Education

This term our Christian value is 'Courage'. Children will learn about this in their RE lessons and during collective worships at the end of each day.

# How can I make a difference?

## PSHE

We will be continuing with the topic of 'Healthy Me', thinking about how our bodies work and how to take care of them. Children should be able to explain how healthy choices affect the way they feel and can help make them happy.



## English

We will be thinking about how we can make a difference and all be friends using a combination of fiction and non-fiction books: The Adventures of Egg Box Dragon, 10 Things I can do to help my world, The Rainbow Fish, Beegu and The Snail and the Whale.



## History

Our focus this term will be significant historical events specific to the local community. This will include learning about the wool sack races.

## Geography

We are going to develop fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of the school environment. We will consider key human and physical features.
