



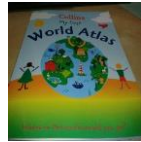

- ### Sticky knowledge
- The world is made up of many countries. (195)
  - The countries can be grouped into continents. (7)
  - The large amounts of water between each continent are called oceans. (5) Seas are smaller than oceans and are usually located where the land and ocean meet.
  - Some of the continents are joined by land. Others are separated by oceans.
  - Human features are made by people and physical features are created by nature
