During this term, we will be writing to entertain and inform through a range of texts both fiction and non fiction. We will be writing in full sentences that make sense using adjectives and correct punctuation. We will be putting emphasis on spelling the year 1 & 2 high frequency words (found on our website) correctly. Every morning the children will be practising their handwriting letter formation and sizing. Please continue to support your children by encouraging them to read frequently.



Maths



Throughout the first term, the children will be developing their knowledge of place value, addition, and subtraction. One of our main focuses will be using our knowledge of place value to solve two-digit sums and obtain higher rates of number recognition and formation. We will be using a range of concrete objects and pictorial reprsentations to aid our understanding in lessons.

In Science, the focus for the first term will consist of Living things and their habitats. We will explore a range of large and microhabitats and expand on how these are suited to provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals. Our lessons will be conducted in both indoor and outdoor formats, combined with the use of our forest school to give the learning real-world application.
