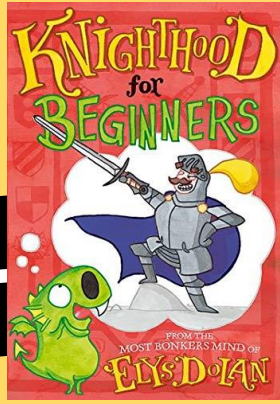
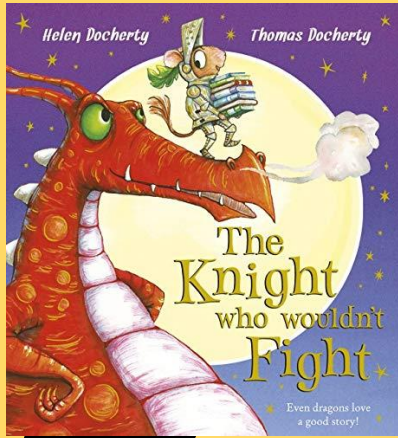
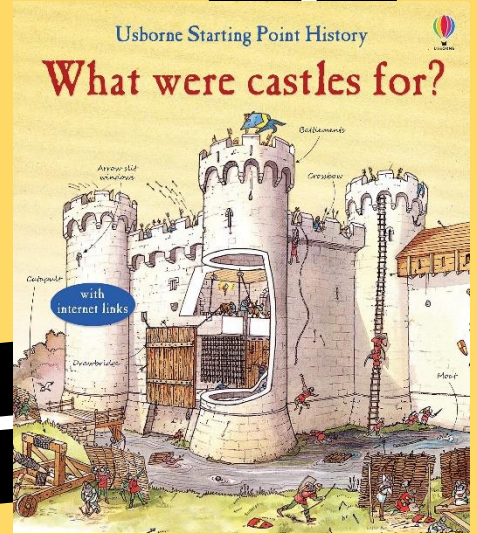

We will read *Knighthood for Beginners* by Elys Dolan. This book will be shared and discussed to ensure children are immersed in the language associated with this topic.

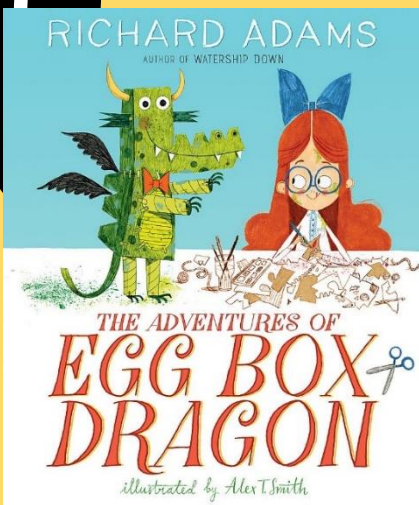
We will use a section of the non-fiction text **What were castles for?** to consider what it took to be a knight. We will use this text for instructional writing and cross-curricular writing in history.
