WELCOME BACK

Welcome back, we hope that you have had a restful Easter holiday. This term, our focus will be on 'The world in our hands', we will be diving into this topic to look at the question: 'What is it like to live by the coast?'

In Maths, we will be looking at recognising and writing fractions of both whole numbers and shape. We will dive into finding halves, quarters, thirds, 3-quarters and building up to a whole. We will be making use of drawings and physical objects to aid us in recognising these different fraction types.

Reading remains important and we aim for children to be heard by an adult as often as we can. All children are heard reading three times a week in their phonics groups and when we do guided reading. You may see a comment or a stamp in their reading records to show this.

In terms of homework, we will be continuing to set the maths work booklets on a weekly basis (to complete a double page spread per week). You will also have a weekly spellings set. Both of these activities will be reviewed on the Friday morning of each week as a whole class.
