



During the final 2 terms of Year 2 we will be securing our learning of skills and using these in our writing. We will do this through quality texts such as Jonny Duddle's, Gigantosaurus. Non-fiction texts about dinosaurs and many more. We will be promoting work on spelling ensuring all the year 2 common exception words are being consistently spelt correctly.

Geography

What is like to live by the coast? We will review knowledge about oceans and seas surrounding the UK, we will identify coastal areas and find them on maps and in atlases. We will look at human and physical features of coastal regions.

Computing

The children will be presenting ideas using a programme using text, images and sound files. We will be using laptops to complete this unit.

Music

We will be looking at how does music connect us with the environment. We will be learning songs with an echo and exploring improvisation using glockenspiels.

Our focus during this term will be learning about relationships. We will be talking about our relationships within our families and with our friends. In term 6 we will be learning about "Changing Me".

Maths

Over term 5, the children will begin their learning of fractions where we will dive into recognising halves, guarters and thirds of numbers and shapes. All of which will allow us to add these up to make a whole.

We will also be consolidating our learning from the year to build up to our Arithmetic and Reasoning Maths SATs tests.



PE

We will be doing gymnastics this term. children will learn to link sequences using clear shapes with control. We will be using some of the larger equipment to support their learning.

RE

During terms 5 & 6 we will be exploring the big questions: How should we care for our world and for others and why does it matter? What does it mean to belong to a faith community?





Animals including humans & Materials and their properties

Science

The children will consolidate the unit of 'Animals' including humans' where we have looked at what we need to grow and survive to be healthy. Throughout our learning of materials, we will explore the suitability of a range of different materials and how we can manipulate these by: squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

History



What happened in the market house & goods shed?

We will explore the above question looking at significant historical events, people and places in our own locality. We will incorporate local walks and invite local people into school to support our learning,

DT

The children will be developing their testing, planning and evaluating skills through designing a moving dinosaur.





The children will look at expressive painting by exploring how painters us paint in expressive & gestural ways. We will explore colour mixing & experimental mark making to create abstract still life.
