

During this term we will continue building narratives, using the book 'The Knight who couldn't fight' to start looking at writing the different parts of a story. We will use a variety of other texts to support our writing to inform and entertain.

Children will be introduced to a variety of grammar concepts, including '-est' and '-er' endings on adjectives.

**Phonics:** We will continue to use the Read Write Inc. scheme to support preparation for the phonics screening check this term. Please continue to support your children by encouraging them to read frequently.
