WELCOME BACK

Welcome back, we hope that you have had a nice half term break and are feeling ready for the term ahead leading up to Easter. This term, our focus will be on 'New Horizons; Explorers, voyagers, invaders & inventors.' We will be using this to look at the question: How did Florence Nightingale change the way we run hospitals?

In Maths, we will be looking at shape and money. Throughout shape, we will be exploring the features of 2D & 3D shapes such as their sides, faces, vertices and the lines of symmetry. Within our topic of money, we will become confident in counting the various coins and notes as well as how to make change from larger sums.

Reading is still very important and we aim for children to be heard by an adult as often as we can. All children are heard reading three times a week in their phonics groups when we do guided reading. You may see a comment or a stamp in their reading records to show this.

In terms of homework, we will be continuing to set the maths work booklets on a weekly basis (to complete a double page spread per week). You will also have a weekly spelling set. Both of these activities will be reviewed on the Friday morning of each week as a whole class.
