


Maths

We will be exploring the place value of numbers to 100 with lots of practical work. We will also be learning about addition and subtraction, using different practical and written methods to help us.



Religious Education

We will be learning about 'What do Christians believe God is like?' and understanding how Christians use worship and prayer to show their beliefs about God as well as retelling some Bible stories.



Who was Mary Anning?

PSHE

Our unit is called 'Being me in my world.' We will be recognising our hopes and fears for the year, identifying our responsibilities within school and knowing how to keep our classroom a safe and happy place.



Computing

Our unit is called 'Coding' We will learn what an algorithm is and create a simple programme using one. We will also be learning about how to stay safe online.



History

We will be using historical enquiry to ask perceptive questions about the life of a significant individual Mary Anning. We will use a range of stories and sources to consider how the past is represented and will identify similarities and differences between Mary Anning's life and our own lives.

Geography

We will be learning about coasts and the impact of natural and human features. We will be focusing on learning vocabulary related to coasts.

DT

We will be designing, making and evaluating a habitat for a dinosaur.

PE

We will be looking at co-ordination, footwork and balance. We will be teaching this through our new PE scheme "Real PE".



Art

We will be looking at coastal landscapes and creating our own landscape using watercolours and texture.

English

This term we will be reading the text Stone Girl, Bone Girl by Laurence Anholt. The children will be completing a variety of writing, including stories, descriptions and instructions. We will also be concentrating on key skills such as writing sentences that make sense and have the correct punctuation.
