



English

The children will continue to enjoy reading their class book each day and sharing texts in Whole Class Guided Reading sessions. Please continue to support your children by encouraging them to read frequently. We will be writing to inform, entertain and explain using our topic as a stimulus. Spelling, punctuation and grammar lessons will take place each week.



Maths



In maths sessions, the children will measure and calculate the perimeter and area of a range of regular and irregular shapes. When working with fractions, they will compare and order, add and subtract, identify equivalent fractions and convert between mixed numbers and improper fractions. In addition, arithmetic skills will be practised daily.

Science

Our work in science this term will look at living things and their habitats. We will investigate and compare the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. We will also describe the life processes of reproduction in some plants and animals.

Computing

The children will develop their database skills to record, store and present information electronically

Geography



In geography, the children will use Ordnance Survey maps, compasses and grid references to build their knowledge of the United Kingdom and the wider world.
