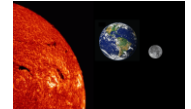
## Maths



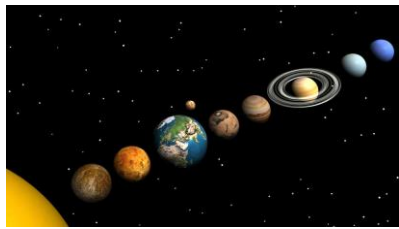
In maths sessions, the children will explore numbers to 1,000,000 and further develop their addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills and apply their knowledge to a variety of problems. The children will also continue daily work on their arithmetic skills.



## Science



Our work in science this term will look at the relationships between the Earth, Sun and Moon. We will also examine how the Earth moves in relation to the Sun and the other planets in the solar system. By the end of their work in science this term the children should be able to explain night and day and the Moon's movement around the Earth.

## Computing

The children will develop their computing skills using the Purple Mash scheme. This term the children will be learning about online safety and coding.

## Geography



In geography, the children will become more confident at naming and locating countries, counties and cities across the world. They will compare similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography and look more in depth at mountains, earthquakes and volcanoes. Children will also be developing their fieldwork skills using maps, atlases, globes and digital mapping to locate countries and describe the features studied.

## Art and Design

## PHSE

Our focus during this term will be focusing on 'Me in My World' where the children will explore their own goals and aspirations and consider their rights and responsibilities as a British citizen.



## RE

## Music
