

Maths

We will be developing an understanding of number. The children will meet the characters from 'Digit Drive' to reinforce number recognition and formation. We will also experiment with pattern during shape and measure sessions.

Religious Education

This term the Christian Value is 'Thankfulness'. We will think about what this means and how we can show it everyday and everywhere. In RE we will learn about Harvest through interesting activities, and think about being special (where do we belong).

Communication & Language

We will encourage good listening skills through games and activities. Children will engage in role play in literacy lessons and in their free play. There will be many opportunities for discussions based around our topic. The children will share their 'Special bags' and tell their friends about their toys and photos etc.

Literacy

We will start to learn and revise the 'Set 1' sounds from our phonics scheme, blending and segmenting them to read and write words!
Together we will enjoy listening to a range of stories and joining in with nursery rhymes. Together we will be learning how to form our cursive letters when we write our names and in phonics!

Understanding the World

We will be accessing technology using iPads. We will learn about castles and listen to the story of Guy Fawkes. We will learn about our environment during our weekly welly walks.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will explore working with different materials, colours and textures to create dragon collages. We will use our imaginations to make models and to paint pictures. We will make 3D models using playdough and clay.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

This term the children will be thinking about their class rules and creating a class charter, discussing why we need these rules. Our topic is 'Being Me in My World' and we will all be getting to know each other by playing games and talking about our likes and dislikes. The children will talk about what makes a good friend and think about what makes them happy and sad.

Physical Development

The children will start their 'Balanceability' sessions and develop their fine motor skills through our 'Funky Fingers' activities. In PE lessons the children will develop basic skills such as skipping, jumping, rolling, as they work at different activities.
