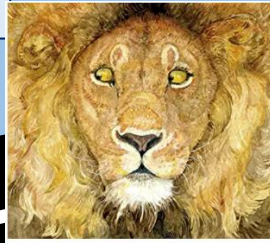
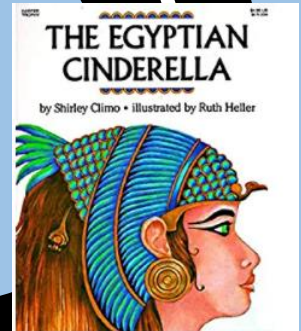


The Promise by Nicola Davies is a whole school text to read. All KS2 classes will read and share this book during the first week of term, learning how to care for each other and our world.



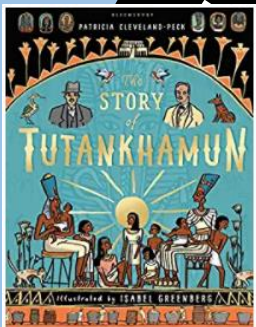
READING FOR PLEASURE

The Lion and The Mouse by Jerry Pinkney... A stunning, wordless version of one of Aesop's best-loved fables offering huge scope to help us retell the fable.

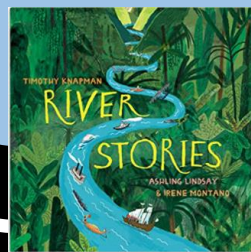
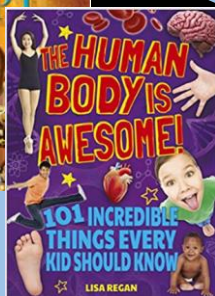
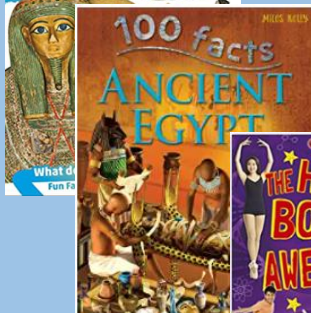
The Story of Tutankhamun by Patricia Cleveland-Peck will help us with our science, topic and non-fiction writing.
