We hope you all had a super Summer break. The children, we are sure, will be fired up and ready to learn during what will be a busy term 1 and 2 in Year 6.

Our **Geography focus** in term 1 is, 'Why does population change?' We will be investigating why certain parts of the world are more populated than others; exploring birth and death rates; discussing social, economic and environmental push and pull factors and learning about the population in Britain and its impacts. Our **History focus** in term 2 will be the **Shang Dynasty**, an ancient Chinese civilization. We will learn what the Bronze Age period was like in China.

We will be having our **weekly spelling check every Friday**. The children will have brought home their list of words for term 1 to learn for homework.

Children need to continue to have rapid recall of all multiplication tables up to 12x12 so please help your child to keep practising their times tables.

Children must also read regularly as it is vital that they can access, read and understand a wide variety of texts on different subjects.

Please encourage and support your child to read regularly, practise their weekly spellings and continue to learn times table facts.

Gentle reminder: for a breaktime snack, children should bring extra fruit or vegetables rather than taking something from their lunch box.
