RE:	Friday 22 <sup>nd</sup>
In RE, we are comparing the Creation story from Genesis with the scientific theory of 'Big Bang'. Your task is to create either a 2-d picture or 3-d representation of an aspect of either the bible story OR the scientific theory. You may want to pick a day from the bible story, or create a 'Big Bang' using collage materials/ paint etc. Get creative!	September
Magic Moments and Morfa Bay: Create one A4 page, full of your amazing magic moments from your time at Morfa Bay. This will be placed in your Magic Moments books in school. If you do not go to Morfa Bay, choose a magic moment of your choice. It may be from the summer holidays or from your first term in Year Six.	Friday 13 <sup>th</sup> October
Science:	Friday 10 <sup>th</sup>
As part of our Science work on classification, your task is to research an animal classified as either a reptile, an amphibian or a mammal. Gather lots of information – its habitat, diet, body features (including what makes it reptile/amphibian/mammal). Present your information in an interesting way – and remember, presentation is important so make your sentences clear.	November
English/History:	Friday 24 <sup>th</sup>
Fine out as much as you can about the founder of the internet – Tim Berners-Lee. Where was he born? What was his early life like? What inspired him? What are his achievements?  This is a fact-finding mission. We will use your research in class as part of our English work.	November
