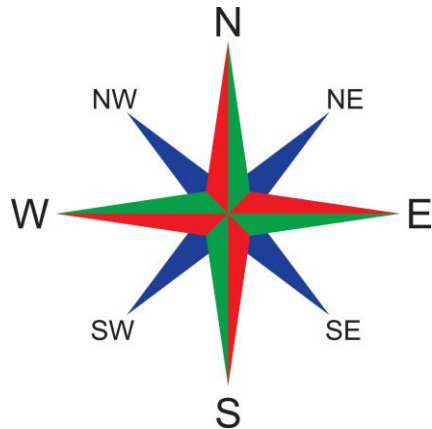


Europe:
