THE STORY- Many religions believe in supporting others and offering forgiveness and kindness. Jesus through his actions, miracles and teaching showed people the Earth that God wanted. He modelled God's spirit on Earth

THE PRACTICE - Jesus spread his ministry through his teachings and trusted disciples. He was a fisher of men and gathered around him 12 special individuals to help him spread the 'Good News'.

'Fishers of men' is a phrase used in the gospels to describe the order given by Jesus to his first disciples.
