<p><b><u>Research</u></b> As this is a new topic, we would like you to research using books and/or the internet. Your aim is to find 10 amazing facts about this civilization and record them neatly in your books. <p><b><u>Mayan Numbers</u></b> The Mayans used their own number system. Find out about it and write down the Mayan numbers 1 – 20.</p>	Friday 10 <sup>th</sup> June
<p><b><u>Artefacts</u></b> An artefact is an object that tells us something about the past. Find out about Mayan artefacts and choose an interesting one to draw. Write a few sentences about it as well, so we know what it shows us or tells about the Mayans.</p>	Friday 24 <sup>th</sup> June
