

1. Using your learning and research skills, create at least six, 'Did you know?' fact cards about the rainforest. Think about making sure that all your facts are interesting and the more unusual they are, the better!

2. **Create a rainforest diorama** - a 3D model in a box. Dioramas are scale models and they usually depict a landscape typically showing nature scenes, or moments in history.

Your box should be no bigger than a cereal / shoe box.

You might choose to...

- show all the layers of the rainforest or choose to focus on one layer
- concentrate on the plants or the animals that live in the rainforest or both
- include labels and other information about the rainforest
