Maths



This will be another busy term as we make our way towards SATs. We will develop knowledge and understanding across a range of topics, including decimals and percentages, algebra, converting between measures, area, perimeter and volume. We will also continue with our highly successful Early Bird Maths.



Science



We will be studying Animals including Humans, focusing on the structure of the circulatory system and the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. We will consider the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on how their bodies function. We will also look at how nutrients and water are transported within animals.

Computing
