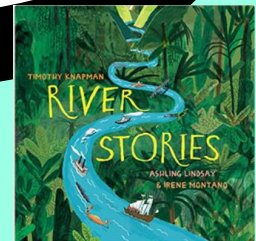
**READING FOR PLEASURE**

Mouse, Bird, Snake, Wolf, Henry's Freedom Box and The Explorer are our core texts. They will provide stimulus for our writing units.

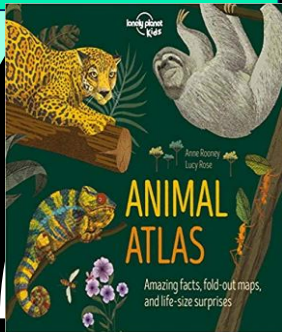


This text will help us achieve our outcomes in the wider curriculum – understanding and describing key features of rainforests and locating the continents of the world.



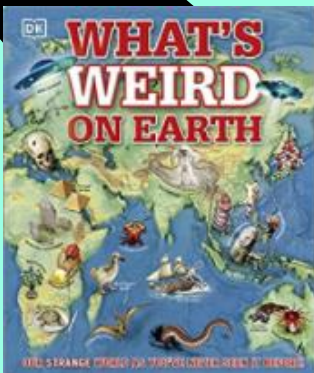
These books are non-fiction books which will provide stimulus for our non-fiction writing unit.

River Stories explores the sights and stories of the world's greatest rivers including the River Amazon

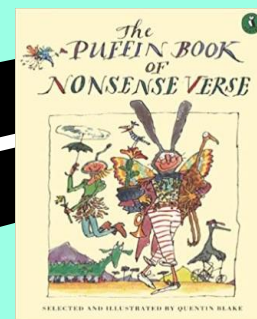


## Year 4's SPRING Reading Road
