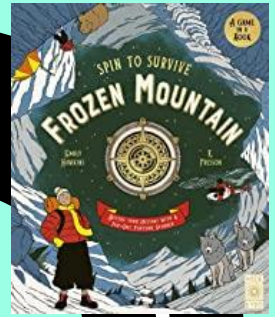


Life on Earth

Why should we protect life on earth?

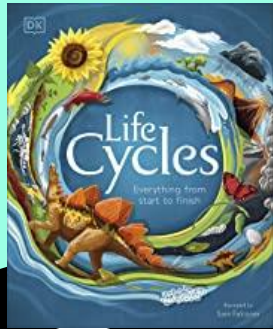


READING FOR PLEASURE
We will read Rumble Star by Abl Elphinstone as our class reader. This book will provide stimulus guided reading.

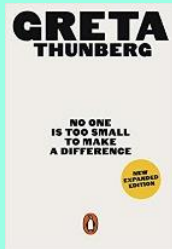


This interactive text, Spin to Survive Frozen Mountain by Emily Hawkins, will provide stimulus for our instructions writing unit.
