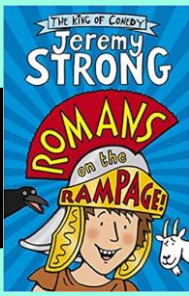
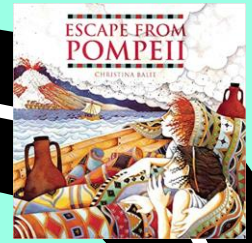

Could you live like a Roman?

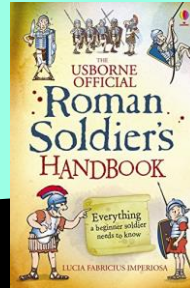
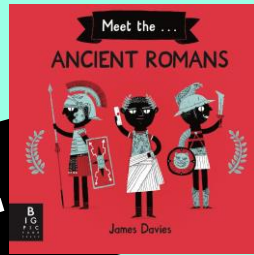


These are our reading for pleasure books. They will feed into our narrative and non-fiction writing.

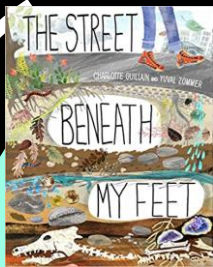


Escape from Pompeii will be our core book. It will provide stimulus for our narrative writing unit.

These non-fiction books will provide stimulus for our writing unit on how to live like a Roman soldier.

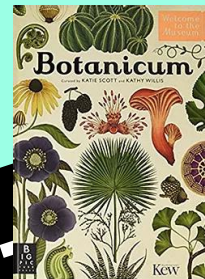


From the risks of living near volcanoes, to battling as part of (or against) the Roman Army, **Courage** permeates through our reading road this term.
