We expect the best homework from your child, work that we know your child is capable of producing. Please support your child with these tasks but don't do them for them!

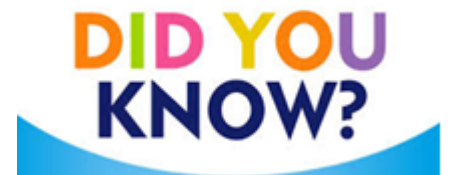
1. Animals and Their Habitats - Design and make a mask of an animal from a habitat that we have been exploring in school. You can choose to ask your teacher for a template to start from and then add ears, feathers, noses, etc. to make your mask. Alternatively, you can choose to start from scratch. A paper plate or a piece of card makes a good base. Take a look at these ideas for inspiration...



Be prepared to share with the class an explanation about your chosen animal's habitat.

2. Using your research skills, create at least six, 'Did you know?' fact cards about rainforests. Think about making sure that all your facts are interesting and the more unusual they are, the better!



Due on Friday 4th March

3. Create a rainforest diorama - a 3D model in a box. Dioramas are scale models and they usually depict a landscape typically showing nature scenes, or moments in history.

Your box must be no bigger than a cereal / shoe box.

You might choose to...

- show all the layers of the rainforest or choose to focus on one layer
- concentrate on the plants or the animals that live in the rainforest or both
- include labels and other information about the rainforest
