

English



We will study the traditional Anglo-Saxon tale of *Beowulf*. After orally retelling the story in their own words, the children will create their own traditional tales. The story will also be the basis for a class debate and the children will create balanced arguments from this.



Maths



The term will start with the children working on their knowledge and understanding of place value.
