## HOLLY and ELM Class

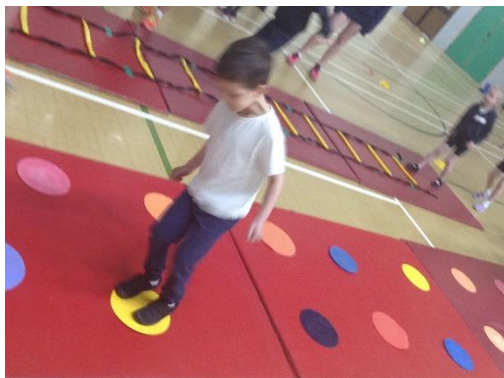
