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## Free school Meals

If you are not receiving Free school meals and you think you may qualify - apply for Free school meals now - instant decision [Apply for free school meals - Gloucestershire County Council](#) (please have your National Insurance number to hand)

Free school meals is not the same as Universal Free School Meals children automatically receive in reception to year 2 - Free school meals attracts additional funding to the school, which can help you with school trips and school events as well as securing your child with a free school meal for the whole time they are in primary school, so even if your child is in reception to year 2 it is also worth applying for free school meals - all approved applications are eligible for a free school jumper (please contact the office to order this, when your application has been approved).

## Milk

Reception Children whose parents/carers have registered for Free school milk (under 5's), are receiving milk in class at the moment. This is not an automatic registration. If you would like to take advantage of the free school milk scheme (for under 5's), please register your child at [www.CoolMilk.co.uk](http://www.CoolMilk.co.uk). Please be aware, as your children turn 5, this will become chargeable and an invoice will be sent to the parent/carer from Coolmilk.

All children who receive FSM (not UNFSM) can have school milk throughout their time at primary, if required. Again parents need to register for this.

If you do not want your child to receive milk in school, the parent/carer will need to cancel it. This should be done via Coolmilk. We are unable to do this in the school office. For further information please look at the coolmilk website or contact the school office.



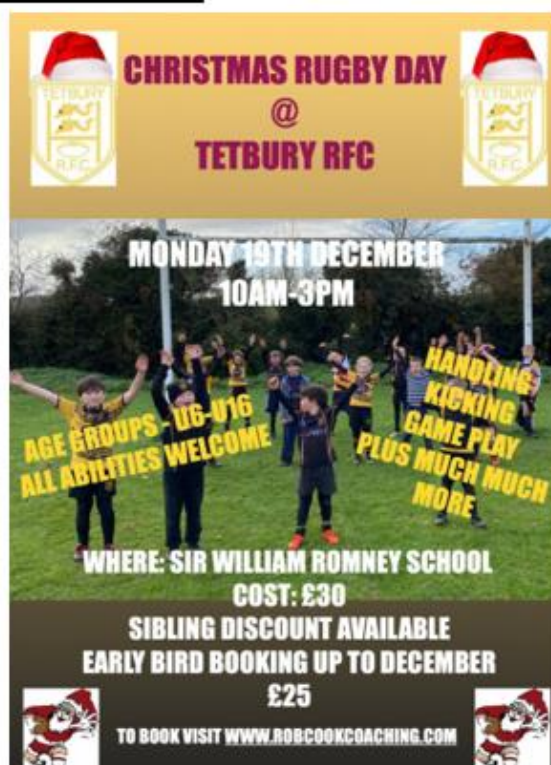
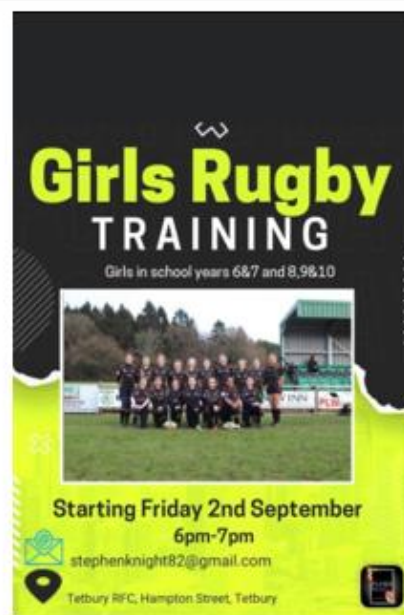
