Dear Parents,

As we reach the end of Term 5 and government restrictions are continuing to ease, I have been reviewing our Covid risk assessment and systems of controls in place in school. As you will have heard in the news, there is still much uncertainty about the further lifting of restrictions in June and I want to reassure parents that we will continue to follow government guidance and advice to reduce the risk of infection our school community.

### Changes to routine after half term:

After half term, children will be permitted to play in year group bubbles at break and lunchtimes.

We will also be reinstating our normal school start and end times. All children should arrive at school between 8.40 and 8.50am. Children will line up outside their classrooms or entrances to school and will be taken in by the staff at 08.50am. Children in EYFS and KS1 will be collected at 15.10 and children in KS2 will finish school at 15.15.


