Dear Parents,

You should have received a letter informing parents about the consultation we are currently undertaking about the possibility of St. Mary's joining the Corinium Education Trust. I hope you have had a chance to read it. There will be a parents' consultation meeting on Monday 28th June for any parents who would like to join a discussion about this. The link to the meeting is in the email sent out earlier in the week.

As we head towards the last few weeks of term we continue to follow the system of controls to ensure we reduce the chances of anyone in our school becoming infected with Covid. 




Dress Down Day!
