Spending	Cost	Impact
Play Leader	£7,043	Play leaders encourage children to participate in physical activities and play. Engaging in regular physical activity helps improve strength, coordination, and overall fitness, reducing the risk of obesity and related health problems.
Forest School	£8,470	Pupils taking part in outdoor and adventurous activities through Forest School. Pupils engaging in physical activity outside benefiting their health and well-being. Supporting staff CPD to enable them to lead other outdoor education sessions at different times in the year.
PE and Sports Equipment	£300	Pupils were able to use new equipment and the school was able to offer a range of sporting activities eg golf after school club.
Sports events	£900	Children participating in local sporting events within the local cluster and district events. Children took part in a range of different activities.
Cricket Coaching		Children participated in cricket coaching workshops from Gloucestershire Cricket. Children learnt new skills and participated in cricket matches. Sparked interest in cricket with more children joining local cricket clubs.
Sportily events	£1,450	Children participated in ball games, target practice and climbing on the climbing wall.
Balanceability	£150	Improved spatial awareness, gross motor control and physical literacy, which boosted confidence in PE and playground games for EYFS / KS1 children. Supported the physical foundation for later involvement in sport by increasing confidence and movement.
OPAL play	£100	Further investment in our OPAL programme, including climbing, balancing and adventure equipment. OPAL aims to greatly increase the physical activity of all children and get more children, more active more of the time, and sustain those benefits over many years. This has been proven through research and evidence available on the OPAL website
