# Report for website

### What is the PE and Sports Grant?

The PE and sports grant is money allocated to schools by the government to improve the provision of PE and Sports for the benefit of primary aged pupils so that they develop healthy lifestyles.

#### How is it allocated?

Allocations for the academic year 2013/14 are calculated using the number of pupils in Years 1 to 6, and those age 5 in Year R, as recorded on January 2013 Census, as follows:

- Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £8,000 plus £5 per eligible pupil; and
- Schools with 16 or fewer eligible pupils receive £500 per eligible pupil.

### How much did St Mary's School get in the academic year 2103 – 2014

The school received £5,639 of PE funding over the academic year 2013-2014.
